This letter is to certify that Salvino Oliveira has received a funding grant from dev.tv, the organization that created and organizes the [Young Activists Summit \(YAS\)](#).

The Young Activists Summit is a global platform that empowers and supports young change-makers working to defend human rights and protect the environment.

In 2025, Salvino Oliveira was selected as one of the five Laureates of the Young Activists Summit. As part of this recognition, he was awarded a grant of CHF 20,000.- to support his work in the Brazilian favelas, aimed at enabling and strengthening access to digital education for young people.

As indicated in the bank statement reference "90% grant_YAS2025", 90% of these funds (CHF 18,000.-) were transferred as part of this grant and are intended exclusively to support this project. The remaining 10% (CHF 2'000.-) will be paid once his field project is completed and report is submitted.


Salvino Oliveira is listed among the Laureates supported by the programme on the [official Young Activists Summit website](#).
